CLUB HISTORY

In 1920 Kelvedon Hatch Football Club was formed to enable the local boys, of what was then a very small Essex village, to play organised football. The Club continued up to the war years, when, like so many other clubs, it was temporarily disbanded and then re-formed in 1946.

Kelvedon Hatch played for many years in local football leagues until the mid 1970's, at which time it applied to join the Greene King South Essex League. The Club was admitted to the League, where it was to play for many years.

In order to progress, the Club applied for membership to the Essex Olympian League, and was admitted as a member in 1985.

The first few years in the League were spent in adjusting to the higher grade football and setting about the task of recruiting better players to assist with the progression of the Club. During a period of ten years the Club achieved outstanding success.

Kelvedon Hatch welcomed Frenford Senior to School Road for this Senior Division Cup Semi Final with near perfect footballing conditions with an immaculate pitch and great weather.

Hatch started by far the brighter of the two sides and forced some early corners that were defended well by Frenford. On 10 mins, from another corner, Hatch took a well deserved lead when Ryan Sammons corner kick was flicked on by Gavin Cooper and into the empty net past their helpless keeper, 1-0. Hatch continued to pressure the Frenford defence and on 19 mins, when from a free kick, Tony Price was fouled inside the box, the linesman flagged giving the referee no choice but to point to the spot. Up stepped Jon Bates, placed the ball on the spot and calmly slotted the ball home, 2-0. Just two minutes after good work out of defence James Burt was put through and brought down in the penalty box, penalty. Bates again dispatched the spot kick without fuss, 3-0. A little later the Frenford keeper, Fenn, handled outside his box, Nick Lowery put the free kick just over the bar. Frenford had a couple of half chances that both went close and wide.

The second half started well for Hatch when Burt burst through on goal but his shot pulled out an excellent save by their keeper, stopping a certain goal. Frenford started to apply some pressure but the Hatch defence, marshalled by Kevin Marsden and Kevin Jopson dealt with. On 55 mins after good work on the left by Bates, who then passed to the fast and impressive James Burt, who beat two players on the left and then rounded their keeper, his accurate cross found Robbie McCarthy for an easy tap in, 4-0. Now came a 20-minute spell in the game that was pretty even. Marsden was replaced by Scott Ballard after tweaking a hamstring. On 76 mins Nick Lowery and Tony Price combined together to put McCarthy through on goal, he coolly dispatched his chance giving their keeper no chance, 5-0. Stuart Jones replaced McCarthy. On 82 mins good work by Jones put Burt through, but again their keeper saved the day. On 82 mins Forbes, of Frenford, received his marching orders for a second yellow card, after a foul on Lowery. From this free kick Ballard headed just over the bar and this was the last notable action of the match and Hatch were through to defend the Cup that they won last season.

The jubilant Kelvedon KOP left for home after seeing a match when nothing went right for visitors Frenford from the first whistle. They had witnessed, at last, a game in which the Hatch could do no wrong with some outstanding performances all round and probably their best performance of the season.

Kelvedon Hatch Reserves travelled to Takeley FC for their League Cup Semi Final on a warm and clear Saturday afternoon with a near perfect playing surface.

It was Takeley who came out the blocks quicker and they had their first chance on 5 mins when the their forward broke down the right cutting inside holding off the Hatch defenders and pulling out a great one handed save from the Hatch keeper, Ian Stanley. This seemed to be the wake up call Hatch needed as they soon got into their stride, working extremely hard all over the pitch to break down the Takeley defence. The first Hatch chance came on 15 mins when a cross into the box wasn't cleared by their defence leaving Tony Sutton a strike on goal but it was well saved by their keeper. 5 minutes later Hatch should have been awarded a penalty, when a Takeley defender controlled the ball with his arm, unfortunately the only person who didn't think it was a spot kick was the referee. Further chances came for Hatch but their keeper pulling of some fantastic saves; Tony Sutton struck a free kick that produced a one handed save to the right corner; Ben Aldorino produced a curling shot from 20 yards that was bound for the top corner, again saved by their impressive keeper. The last 15 mins of the half saw Hatch play some of their best football of the match applying pressure on the defence with good crosses from Martin King and Terry Wright which the Hatch forwards were unable to finish off. Takeley tried to come back late in the half but the impressive Hatch defence dealt competently with any Takeley advances, 0-0 at the break.

The second half saw much fewer chances with probably one good chance going to each team. On 60 mins after some good football, a Takeley forward had found some space 12 yards out from goal only to pull his shot wide of the post. On 65 mins Philip Dear replaced the injured Martin King. On 70 mins Dean Walker latched onto a through ball for a one on one with their goalkeeper, his shot was straight at the keeper who easily saved. The rest of the normal time saw few chances and finished 0-0.

With only 2 mins played in extra time and to the surprise of both teams, Takeley were awarded a very dubious penalty when Evan Jelliss was deemed to have fouled a Takeley player, while heading the ball clear from a corner. The Takeley forward calmly converted the spot kick, 1-0. Hatch worked tirelessly to try and get an equaliser and with both teams tiring and the spaces starting to appear. The closest Hatch came was a great 25 yard effort from Phil Dear that struck the cross bar.

At the start of the second half of extra time James Imber replaced James McCayna in an attempt to score an equaliser. With 10 mins left to play, Takeley sealed their place in the final, when a cross from the right was met by their winger who headed into the bottom right hand corner, 2-0. Hatch tried to get back into the game but the Takeley defence held firm and they ran out 2-0 winners after extra time.

A great team effort by all the Hatch players who had committed everything in this very hard fought cup semi final.
