CODE OF CONDUCT

Each team and individual is responsible to the Canterbury Eagles Management Committee for the actions of its players, parents and spectators.

1) CLUB OFFICIALS, MANAGERS AND COACHES

- a) All officials of the Club must respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person and treat them with equality and respect.
- b) The safety and well being of each player is paramount.
- c) Officials must always promote the positive aspects of football and never condone violation of the laws of the game or its rules and regulations.
- d) Officials will always lead by example, not using or tolerating bad language or bad behaviour.

2) PLAYERS

A bona-fide Canterbury Eagles player may be deemed a member once he/she has signed and returned all of the appropriate forms and membership fees to the Club Secretary and had their application accepted. The player is then expected to adhere to all of the Club, KCFA and EKYFL rules.

- a) All players whilst in Club colours or kit will always be on their very best behaviour.
- b) No swearing or inappropriate language.
- c) Always act in a respectful and sporting manner towards the Referee, Match Officials, opponents and all spectators.
- d) Always abide by the rules and spirit of the game.
- e) Abide by the instructions of their team Manager and Coach.
- f) Pay their training and match subscriptions weekly.

3) PARENTS AND SPECTATORS

- a) Parents and spectators should appreciate good football by applauding both teams and strive to maintain the high reputation that Canterbury Eagles has earned in previous years.
- b) Parents and spectators must be aware that if they fail to act in a sporting manner their child’s Club will be judged by their behaviour.
- c) All Parents and spectators must view the game from the side lines and not from behind the goal. Goalkeepers should not feel intimidated in any way.
- d) Parents and spectators must not appeal to the Referee for throw-ins, fouls, corners, offsides etc. Always show the Referee respect.
- e) Parents must never argue with Club officials from either team, Match officials, other spectators or players.
- f) Parents and spectators must not “coach” during the game. Players will be given instructions by their Manager/Coach.
- g) Support your children but also encourage all other players on the pitch.

WIN LOSE OR DRAW, OFFICIALS, PLAYERS AND PARENTS SHOULD APPRECIATE THE EFFORTS OF EVERYONE INVOLVED IN THE GAME.

THE MAIN AIM IS FOR US ALL TO ENJOY FOOTBALL.

Any breach of the Club rules may result in the Parent, Spectator and ultimately the Player being suspended or banned by the Management Committee of Canterbury Eagles F.C.
