ANTI-BULLYING POLICY

Canterbury Eagles will not tolerate any form of bullying within the Club, whether it emanates from or is directed towards a player, manager, official or parent.

- 1) Any Manager who is witness to any form of bullying within their team must address the issue immediately with the parties concerned and explain the Club policy and expectations of behaviour. The incident should then be reported to the Club Welfare Officer.
- 2) Any Club Official who is concerned about any form of bullying should report it to the CWO and the Manager of the team concerned.
- 3) If a player or parent raises a concern, the CWO must be informed and will then investigate the matter.
- 4) All parties concerned will be interviewed by the CWO or if preferred can put their concerns in writing.
- 5) All parties concerned will be informed of the outcome of the investigation and if necessary action will be taken under the Complaints Procedure.
